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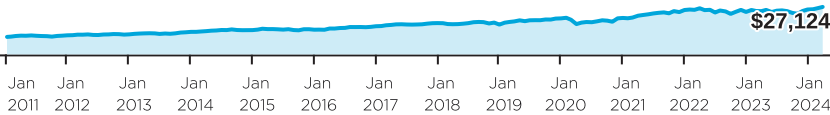

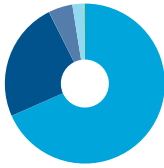

**GROWTH OF \$10,000**

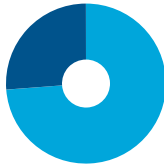


**ASSET ALLOCATION**



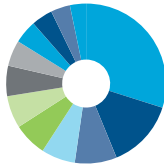
